RE Report (Andy L.)

- 10 renewals in January
- MidDiv convention - Neither us nor neighboring regions sent anyone
- National convention - watched recordings, highlights include
 - insurance changes, esp. WRT property damage
 - pushing online learning for workers
 - new online sanction and auditing process coming up
 - a new push for a shared template system for region websites still under development, wont be ready until at least summer
- Renewal of TN business license - TN has a new system, started preparations to do it
- Renewal of SCCA charter - done

Treasurer's Report (Jane A.)

We have \$13,714.36 in checking at the end of February.

Non-event: expenses since November consisted of three \$5 bank service charges. \$143.70 and \$76.90 to Oyler for website hosting and domain registration, \$521 to KP for trailer storage, \$476.22 to TomP for miscellaneous Solo and treasurer expenses, \$30 for Mid-Div dues, and \$414.40 to AL for awards. Income consisted of \$140+190+130 in membership payables

We should keep savings on hand sufficient to replace the trailer if it is stolen and wholly unrecovered - we currently only have \$2k.

12/07 AX: expenses consisted of \$594 and \$135 to SCCA for sanction-and-insurance and weekend memberships, and \$920 to SBLS for lot rental. Income consisted of \$121.45 from Square, \$135 in cash, and \$1542.41 from MSR.

Awards banquet: expenses consisted of \$400 and \$762.76 to Central BBQ for the awards banquet. Income consisted of a \$360 cash, and \$274.08 from Square.

Solo Report (Alex M.)

- Have a contract with fee structure and schedule worked out with LBMS
 - Roughly \$525 + \$10ea 1st30 and \$20ea 31+ drivers

- Dates are a mix of 1 and 2 day weekends, through at least June
- First available one will be 3/28 - will need to hustle to get sanction and insurance filed
- No leads on new venues
 - Aware of but haven't investigated the airport in Halls (Dyersburg AFB)

Race Report (KP):

- MidDiv sched isn't finished but there will be Super Tour and Majors races
- Our local drivers went to RATL - Don Tucker 3rd in EP, Drago is back in an SM, Rob Horrell DNS'ed, Weber went to hang out

Old Business:

- T-Shirts - We have gotten an estimate from the new T-shirt producer (Collierville Screen Print)
 - Total just under \$700, some of which will be one-time setup fees. Planning on 10 S, M, XL, 20 large
 - Adam H. proposed refreshing shirts periodically using a recent dramatic photo. Would be new setup fee from the T-shirt producer each time.

New Business:

- Having a presence at local cars and coffee events or other car shows
 - Which ones might actually have people interested in AX, and be worth our time to go to?
 - Probably Cars and Coffee, most of the more elder-age groups tend to be drag racers, street racer types more likely have cars that would be fun but less likely to play by the rules
 - There's an argument to be made that the focus should be on making events run smoother with the numbers we have vs. recruiting for more
 - We still have a decent number of business/info cards to spread around, might print out a few more in the near future
