RE Report (Andy L.)

- Membership report from national hasn't come out yet this month

Treasurer's Report (Jane A.)

We have \$14,637.30 in checking at the end of April.

Non-event: expenses since March consisted of the \$5 bank service charge, and \$687.04 to Andy for T-shirts. Income consisted of \$230 in membership payables, and \$250 for T-shirts.

4/19 AX: Expenses consisted of \$891 to SCCA for sanction and insurance, and \$320 for weekend memberships. Income consisted of \$355 in cash, \$220.35 from Square, and \$2291.10 from MSR.

Lost quite a bit, surprising with 54 drivers, because of the new pricing structure.

Solo Report (Alex M. Via Andy L.)

- Has invoices for gas and mileage, beverages, and a Facebook ad, some of which may be scrutinized more in the future
- First event had 54 drivers, 15 weekend memberships
- Andy and Alex met with them in person to discuss invoice
 - \$320 for supervisor, which they split across the multiple events on a site usually, and probably biased towards the larger event – they usually don't intend to bill us that whole amount
 - May event was cancelled due to multiple bookings for the lot, they're comping us "the site fees" for the next event to make up for it.
- Took out a \$15 ad which did seem to bring new faces to the April event.
 - Might be a good idea for RMHC or larger sites that can handle more drivers, but at 50+ drivers at LBMS, we're at capacity.

- Next event is in June, with a possible date in July if it's temperate

Race Report (Weber Manning via Ken P. via Andy L):

- Next event will be April 24th/26th at Hallet
 - Drago in SM placed 13/29th on Sat but DNF'ed Sun
 - Dane Smith DNFed on Sat, placed 1st in GT1 on Sun
 - Tom Smith in GT1 DNSed both days

Old Business:

- SCCA charter audit – it's all uploaded, boxes checked
- Possibilities for new venues – maybe a bit more urgent now if LBMS is going to be busier or flakier in the future.
 - Holly Springs – Jabbo is the current manager, should be plausible
 - Tupelo
 - Tunica – need a new contact
 - Raleigh Springs Civic Center (formerly Mall) – much smaller as the Civic Center than it was as the Mall,
 - Truck driving school at NAS Millington
 - Truck storage lot on Getwell – still visible
