RE Report (Andy L.)

Treasurer's Report (Jane A.)

We have \$13,501.08 in checking at the end of June.

Non-event: expenses since April consisted of the \$5 bank service charge. Income consisted of \$145 in membership payables.

6/29+30 AX: Income consisted of \$215.78 from Square. Most expenses and income will have happened in July.

Discrepancies: Andy has \$25 in his Venmo for a t-shirt sale to an unknown party. The Noltes had an unexpected charge from signing up with a weekend membership despite having a normal membership – it is unknown if they bought a T-shirt, but Alex is investigating. SCCA is refunding the weekend membership fee.
